

Transportation Technologies for Fuel Economy Improvement

The ETV Greenhouse Gas Technology Center, operated by Southern Research Institute (SRI), is soliciting vendors of transportation industry technologies that provide improvements in fuel consumption or reduce greenhouse gas emissions from all transportation sectors (i.e. on- and off-road vehicles, light- and heavy-duty vehicles, locomotives, and marine vehicles) for independent performance verification testing. Technologies must be commercial-ready. Examples include: improved engine and axle lubricants, fuel and fuel additives, diesel engine modifications, add-on control equipment, improved vehicle heating and cooling technologies, and auxiliary power units.
